## Sunday Morning:

### Nursery

The nursery is available for infants and toddlers to play while their parents join a Sunday school class if so desired.

Sunday School is held every Sunday morning, 9:00 - 10:00 AM, for all ages.

Preschool - junior high youth gather downstairs for an opening time of sharing, announcements, celebrating birthdays, and singing until 9:15, followed by age-appropriate Sunday school classes until 10:00.

High school age students (Mennonite Youth Fellowship) go directly to their Sunday school class downstairs.



### Children's Church

There are special activities downstairs geared for children ages 4 years old—2nd grade during the worship service on Sunday morning. Children are dismissed from the worship service after a brief time with the **entire congregation to go to Children's Church.**



## Wednesday Evenings:

### Venture Club

Venture Club is for ages 4 years old - 5th grade from October-March. Bible-based activities include arts & crafts, games, Bible memory, and fun.

### Junior Youth

Junior Youth is for 6th, 7th, and 8th graders from October - March. Activities include Bible study, discussion, games, fun, service projects, Snow Camp, and fellowship.



### MYF

Mennonite Youth Fellowship (MYF) is for youth in High School. Activities include Bible study, discussion, games, service projects, Snow Camp, Mennonite Church Youth Convention, and fellowship.



## Other Programs:

### Vacation Bible School

Vacation Bible School is generally held for one week in the early summer for ages 4 years old - 8th grade. Activities include Bible stories, Bible memory, arts & crafts, group activities, singing, and drama.



### Mentors

Mentors are adults paired up with youth in Junior High and High School to be another guide for each young person in their spiritual journey.
